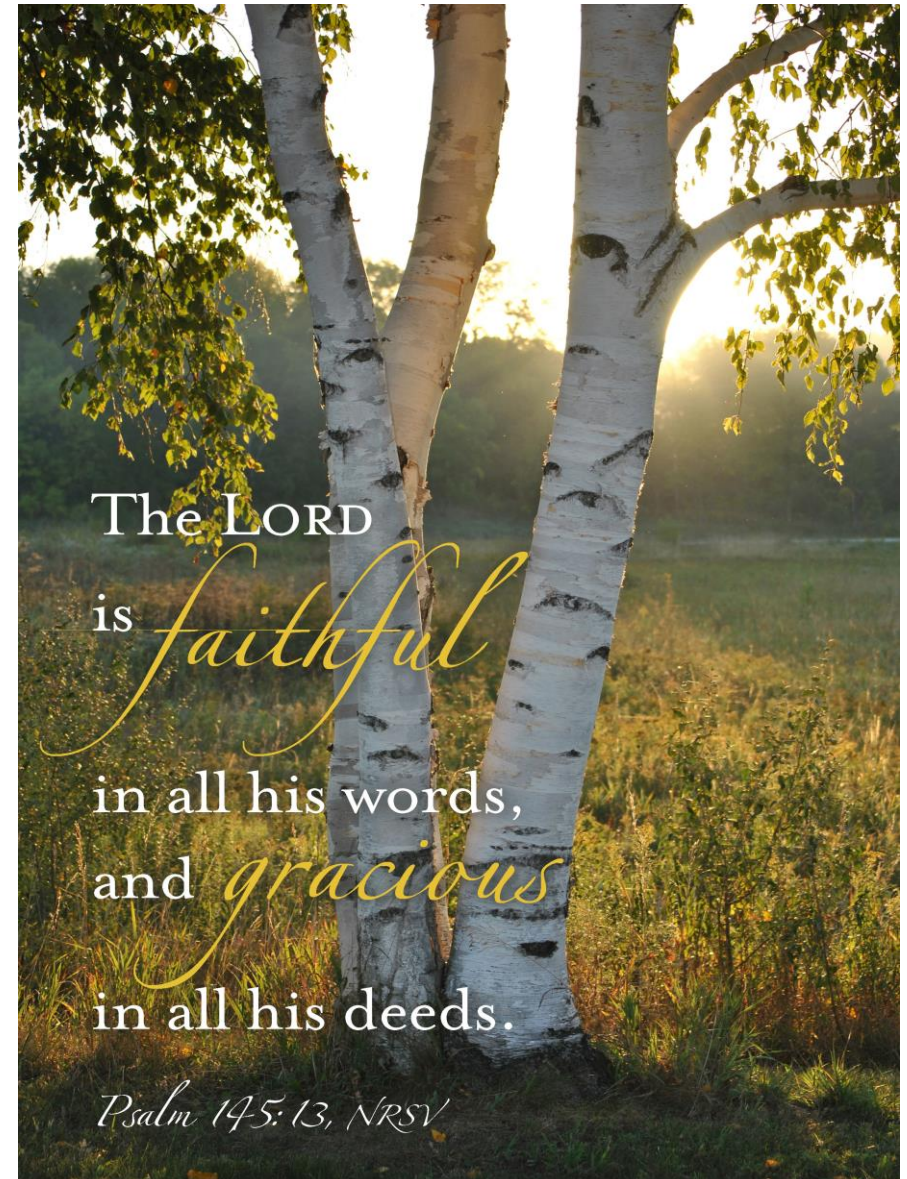


TODAY'S SCRIPTURE READING

- 7 They celebrate your abundant goodness and joyfully sing of your righteousness.
- 8 The LORD is gracious and compassionate, slow to anger and rich in love.
