## **SUMMER INTERN JOB OPPORTUNITIES**

We are excited that we have two summer student positions available this summer for our children and youth ministry. These positions are funded primarily by the Federal government as part of the Canada Summer Jobs program. Those who would be interested in serving the children and youth of our church and community must be currently between the ages of 15-30, being in full-time studies, and be returning to full-time studies in the fall. Both positions are for 30 hours a week for 7 weeks. The first position is for a **summer programs coordinator**. The second is for a **technology coordinator and administrator**. Both people must be available for our VBS outreach (August 14-18). The summer program coordinator will help run other outreach opportunities as well as help with much of our summer programming and organization for fall activities. Our second position is for a **Technology Coordinator and Administrator**. This person will help with organizing and facilitating the tech side (both digital and physical) of many of our programs in hopes of improving them and implementing best practices of social media outreach. This person may also organize outreach opportunities through tech workshops as well as help with our regular summer programming. There is a lot of flexibility and possibility for applicants to develop and pursue their own interests within a few set requirements.
