Scripture

“Don’t let anyone look down on you because you are young, but set an example for the believers in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith and in purity.” -1 Timothy 4:12

“This is the confidence we have in approaching God: that if we ask anything according to his will, he hears us.” -1 John 5:14

Specific Prayer Requests



1. Schools — Our children spend a large amount of their time in school. Pray that our schools would be places of safety-spiritually, emotionally and physically.



2. Families — Pray for strength and health for families. Also, specifically pray for children who live with the reality of family conflict and tension daily.



3. Churches — Pray that the Canadian Church would know how best to reach and disciple children and families for Jesus.



4. Spiritual Depth — Pray that children will discover God and seek a relationship with Him.

5. Missional Heart — Pray that children will respond to God’s invitation of compassion to serve, not only their church but their local and global communities

Prayer Requests for National Day of Prayer for Children

- Pray for unity. Ask God to help the Church build bridges.
- Pray for caring adults to invest in the lives of the kids today.
