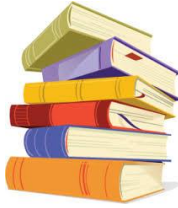

Organization:

Joint venture with Canadian Baptist Ministries, Kabuganaan Philippines Ministries, Inc. and Capiznon Baptist Churches Incorporated

Location: Manila, Philippines

Ministry: The Food for Life Program provides seeds and fertilizers to farmers in the program. At harvest, the farmers pay back to the program without interest. This allows the farmers to sell their product at a fair market price.

The farmers no longer have to deal with wealthy traders who charge extravagant prices.

By providing education in more efficient farm practices, farmers will be able to keep more of their own produce for personal consumption and allow families to purchase food between harvests.

Food for Life will make safe, locally grown food available to local consumers. Markets are currently mixing local production with foreign imports that have been genetically modified and tainted with harmful chemicals. Food for Life will provide certainty to the market and provide consumers with assured quality and environmental standards.
