The 2:7 Series is a 11-week discipleship training curriculum done in small discussion groups. What is the significance of the name *The 2:7 Series*? The name is based on the Scripture reference Colossians 2:7—the statement of the Apostle Paul to a New Testament church: “Rooted and built up in Him, strengthened in the faith as you were taught, and overflowing with thankfulness.” What the Holy Spirit expresses through Paul in this passage clearly defines the specific goals of this training:

1. For a Christian to become built up in Christ and strengthened (or established) in his or her faith. This series includes instruction in practical Bible study techniques, Scripture memory skills, devotional life, and how to be more effective in evangelism.
2. For a Christian to learn to overflow with gratitude in everyday life. The series will help an individual learn to experience and enjoy a stable and consistent Christian walk.

There will be two separate 2:7 small groups offered this fall. You can attend either Tuesday or Thursday night. **The groups start Sept. 19 and 21 at 7:00 pm.
